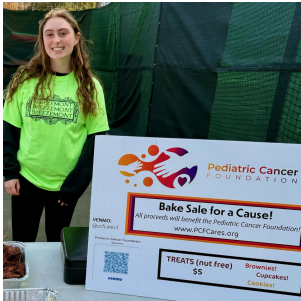

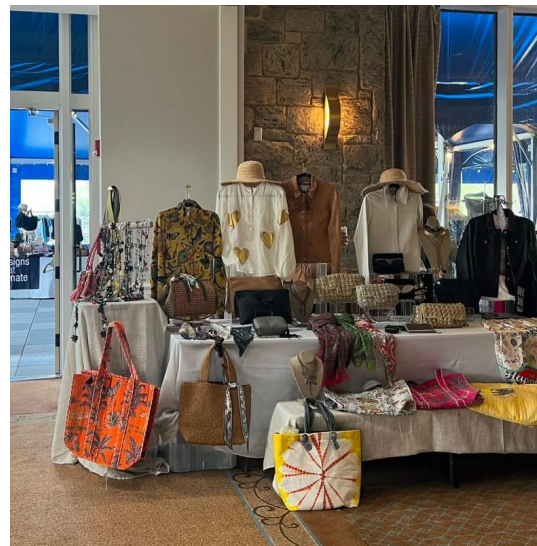
Summer Camp-a-thon
